GENERAL RULES FOR BOTH COMPETITIONS

- Artwork on entries should be original, having a classical Greek or Roman theme.
- Entries should have dark, clear lines, cleanly drawn
- Identification of artist, grade, school, teacher should be on Flipgrid
- Submit entry via Flipgrid flipgrid.com/29a123e4 by Friday, Feb. 25, 2022 at 10 pm
- All entries become the property of the Philadelphia Classical Society.

SPECIFIC RULES FOR THE NOTEPAD COMPETITION

INK: Black (ballpoint, flair, India ink) on white, unlined paper only. No pencil.

DRAWING SIZE: Minimum 3" x 5"; Maximum 7" x 9"

NOTA BENE: The initials PCS and the artist's initials should appear conspicuously.

SPECIFIC RULES FOR THE TEE SHIRT COMPETITION

INK: Black (ballpoint, flair, India ink) on white, unlined paper only. No pencil.

DRAWING SIZE: Minimum 5" x 7"; Maximum 8 1/2" x 11"

NOTA BENE: Drawing appears on the back of the tee shirt with the aphorism (for aphorism, see above).
